

TRAVEL INFORMATION TO ENTER AND DEPARTURE FROM THE REPUBLIC OF GUINEA DUE TO CORONA VIRUS (COVID-19)

The Embassy of the Republic of Guinea would like to inform all passengers entering and leaving the country to abide by the following rules.

ENTERING GUINEA

- Face mask must be worn by all travellers during the entire journey
- All passengers must at least have three (3) facial masks
- Debarkation will be done by the airline sixty (60) passengers at the time starting from business class, to the end of the cabin, respecting social distancing 1 metre.
- Passengers will complete a health declaration form on the plane.
- Passengers must provide a COVID-19 negative certificate issued within seven (7) days.
- Passengers will be subject to a temperature check and a routine health control.
- In case of the suspected symptoms (fever, cough, breathing difficulty, sneezing) the passenger will be confined and tested for Corona virus and will not be released until the test is completed. In case of the positive result the individual will be transferred to a designated centre.
- All passengers will be monitored to a fourteen (14) days from the date of arrival. They will have to leave their contact details (phone number and address) to facilitate contact and trace by the ANSS (National Health Security Agency)
- Guineans repatriated by humanitarian flights who do not hold a negative certificate on departure will automatically be subject to a COVID-19 test and confined until the test results.
- A certificate will be delivered to all passengers at the end of the fourteen days period.

Departure from Guinea

- All passengers must provide a COVID-19 negative certificate issued within seven (7) days before travelling.
- All passengers who do not dispose of the negative certificate will not be permitted to travel
- Passenger will be subjected to a systematic health control from the parking at the airport till departure.
